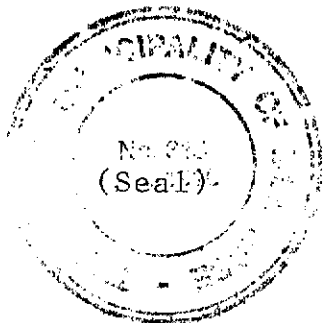


Bylaw No.1994-1

A bylaw of the R.M. of Montrose No. 315 to amend Bylaw No.1983-2 known as The Zoning Bylaw.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Montrose No. 315 in the Province of Saskatchewan in open meeting hereby enacts as follows:

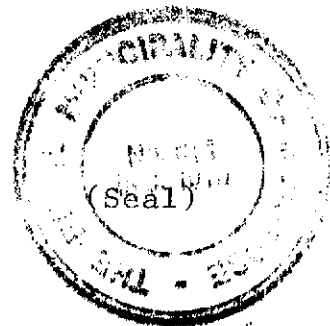
1. Bylaw No. 1983-2 is amended as hereinafter set forth.
2. Part V, Section 1. A - Agricultural District is amended by adding the following to Section 1.3  
Uses Permitted at Council's Discretion
  - i) Multiple unit dwellings and accessory uses.
3. Part V, Section 2. AR - Agricultural Residential District is amended by adding the following to Section 2.2.6  
Uses Permitted at Council's Discretion
  - i) Multiple unit dwellings and accessory uses.
4. Part VI Definitions is amended by adding the following:  
Dwelling, Multiple Unit - shall mean a building divided into three or more dwelling units as herein defined, and shall include town or row houses as distinct from rooming or boarding houses, hotel or motel.  
Dwelling Unit - shall mean one or more habitable rooms constituting a self-contained unit used as a residence, each unit having provision for sleeping, cooking and toilet facilities.
5. The bylaw shall come into force on the date of final approval by the Minister of Municipal Government.
